#### THE NICENE CREED, 880

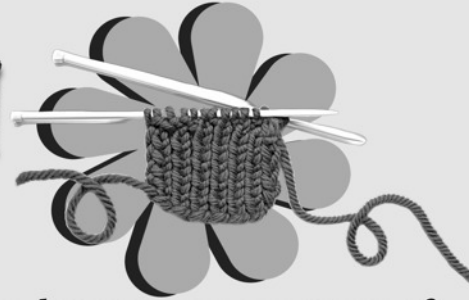
